landed in the wrong place. Within moments of landing they were engaged by experienced German soldiers—Sandy's co-pilot was shot through the chest and died, Sandy himself was taken prisoner.

Sandy's 'Jesus moment' came when he climbed into the cockpit of the glider: his co-pilot, when they landed in Normandy.

A week or so later he and a friend escaped from the Germans and were picked up by the resistance—they hid in Reims until the Americans got there and that is where his picture was taken.

I have to say that I always have the feeling that I owe him something. Simply this, if he and his generation had not destroyed Nazism, then my generation would have had to do the job. They gave their life for me. Do you see that?
